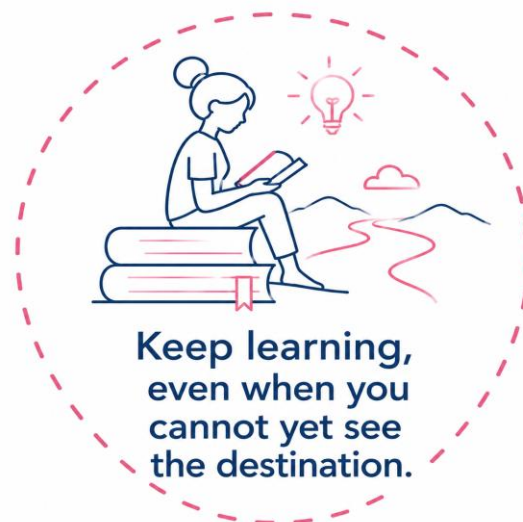
If you could speak to your younger self Kelly...
